The Neighborhood Conservation project scope for the Chestnut Hills Park within the Yorktown Community shall include:

- 1) Improvements to the frontage of the site: a new, set-back fence encompassing the lots on either end of the park with gated entrances; potentially 2 crosswalks with nubs for traffic calming; potentially 3-5 Carlyle lights between the fence and the sidewalk; improvements to the sidewalk to enhance ADA accessibility; potentially pervious paving along the edge of the sidewalk in certain areas to provide a wider surface.
- 2) Improvements to the portable toilet: an accessible pathway leading from the playground to the unit, potentially rubber mats to remove mud from shoes, a new enclosure for the unit.
- 3) Improvements to enhance integration between the main playground and the side lots: a concrete pathway to provide linkages, benches, potentially picnic tables.
- 4) Landscape improvements: trimming back or removing dead/dying/non-native plants that interfere with the fence's relocation, associated grading, minimal planting with natives to enhance curb appeal.
